## Advertisement for Guest Faculty (Assistant Professor)

### AT CENTRE FOR POLICE ADMINISTRATION, PANJAB UNIVERSITY, CHANDIGARH

Centre for Police Administration invites applications for the post of Assistant Professor (Guest Faculty - 2) to teach M.A. (Police Administration) (Session 2024-2025).

#### Qualifications:

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (50% for SC/ST/ Physically & Visually Handicapped) or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed in Police Administration from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in Police Administration in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be.

*Provided, further, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-*

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D. work in conferences /seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

*The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the D an (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.*

- iii) NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

The candidate shall have to give an undertaking that he/she will not draw any fellowship/stipend or any financial assistance from any agency till he/she is teaching in the Centre for Police Administration as a Guest Faculty.
